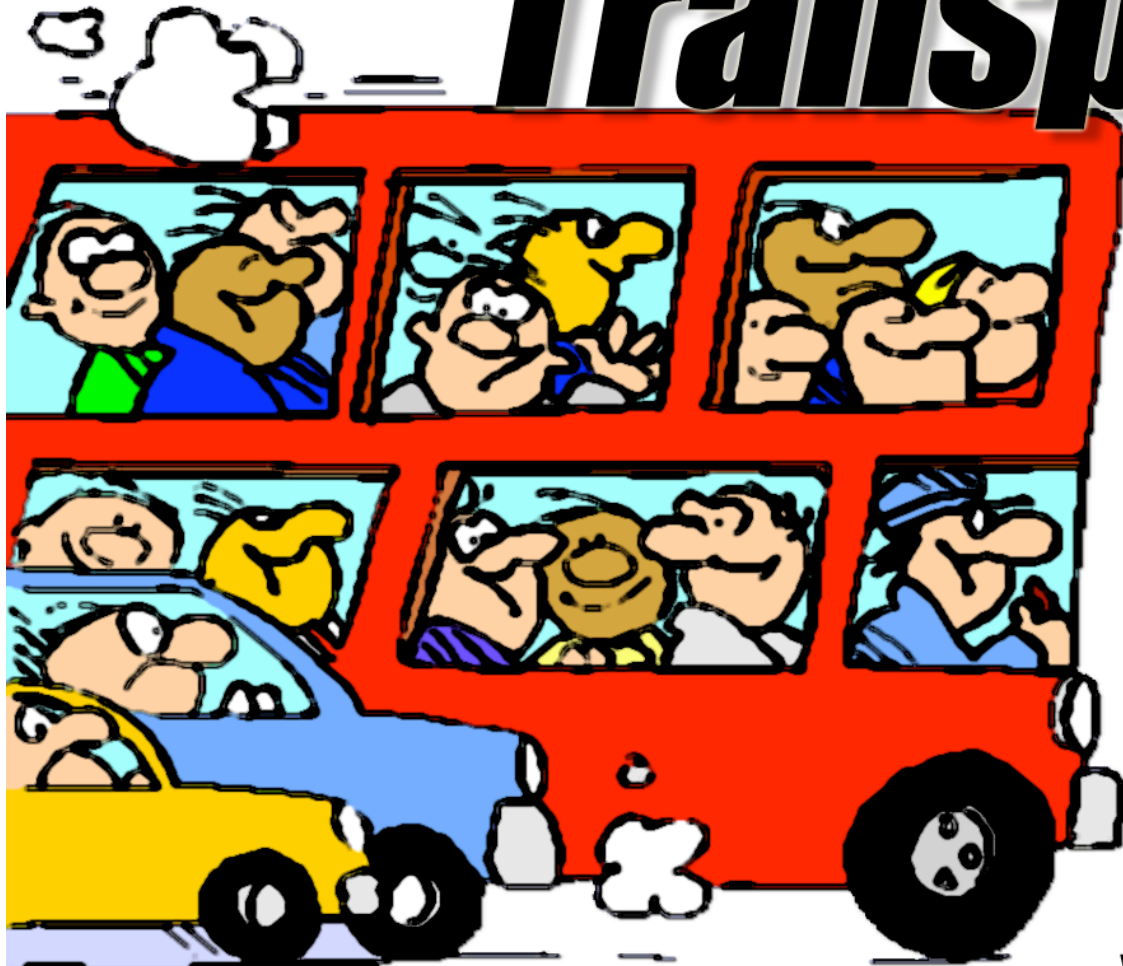


Transportation for All ^{of} St. Louis
