Working people hear that they should be happy that unemployment is rising at a slower rate, as if that somehow translates into jobs.

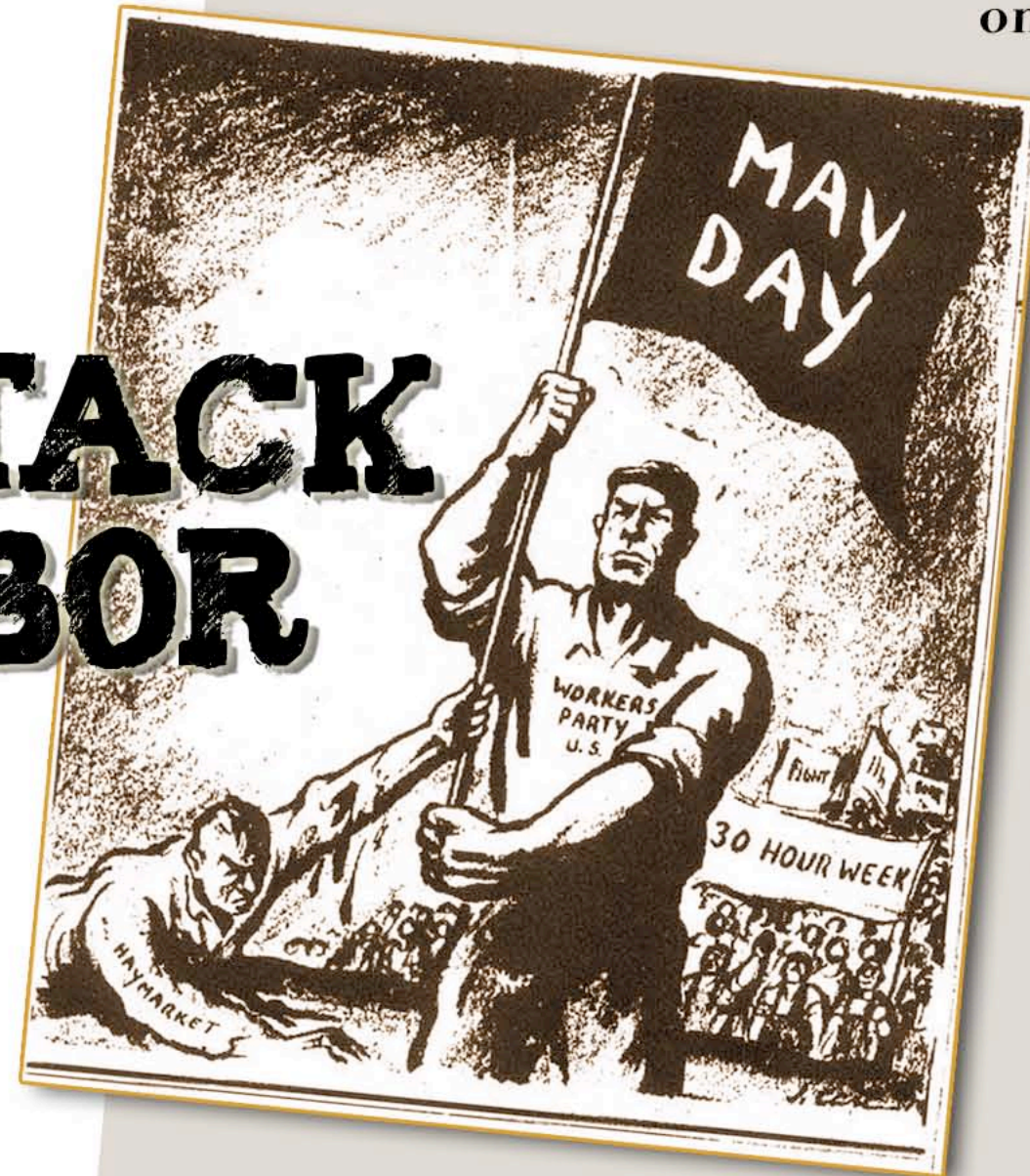
The politicians refuse to consider single payer health care and instead hawk a plan that would leave millions of Americans with inadequate protection while guaranteeing billions to the insurance industry.
